Changes to RIDDOR

RIDDOR has gone under a number of changes in the last year. In September, the requirement to report incidents on line came into effect. On 6th April 2012, the number of consecutive days a person is unavailable for work before the injury becomes notifiable changes from the current 3 days to 7.

HOW DO I REPORT AN ACCIDENT?

All accident must now be reported online [here](#), with the exception of Dangerous Occurrences and deaths which must be reported by the quickest means - call the Incident Contact Centre on 0845 300 9923 (opening hours Monday to Friday 8.30 am to 5 pm).



Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 1995 should be made online through 7 online reporting forms to make the statutory reporting process quick and easy.

These RIDDOR changes present an opportunity for employers to make sure they understand the process, but also to educate their workforce on what is required of them so they are always compliant.
